Dr. King's prestigious accomplishments include:

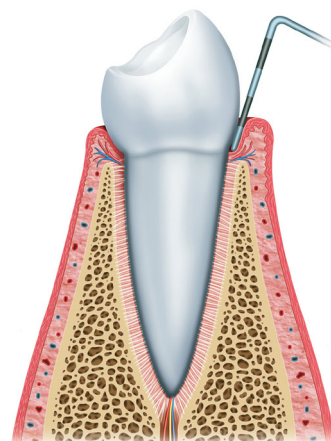
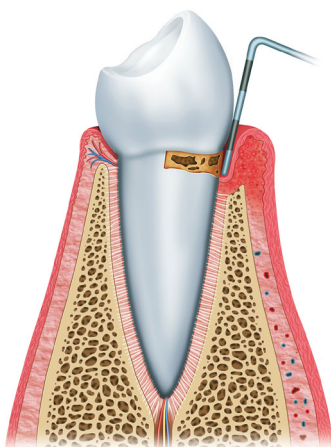
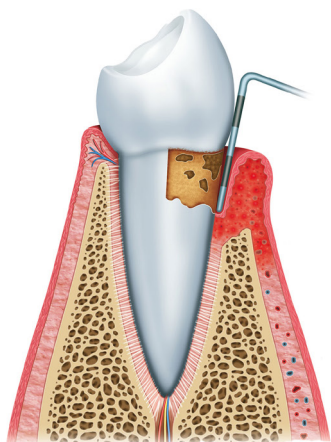
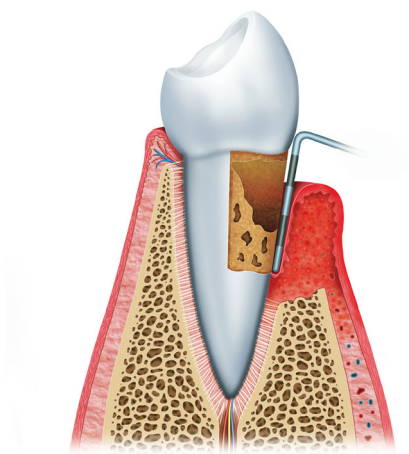
- Becoming one of the youngest women to achieve Mastership in the Academy of General Dentistry (AGD), July 2006.

What is Periodontal Disease?

Periodontal disease is the technical name for gum disease. The name itself may seem pretty self-explanatory, but periodontal disease can be a complex thing. For starters, periodontal disease has three stages: gingivitis, periodontitis and advanced periodontitis. Most people have heard of gingivitis. This earliest stage develops as plaque builds up along the gum line. If this plaque is not removed with daily brushing and flossing, it can progress into periodontitis. In some cases, patients with gingivitis also experience minor bleeding in the gums. The good news is that, if caught early, gingivitis is completely treatable and reversible. The bad news is that if it's not treated, it can progress into periodontitis. Periodontitis occurs when the plaque buildup from gingivitis is not removed and continues to irritate the gums. As a result, the gums form periodontal pockets beneath the gum line. Periodontal pockets can trap food and more plaque and, if left untreated, can allow your condition to worsen until it reaches advanced periodontitis.

Advanced periodontitis is when the infection has become so severe that the fibers holding your teeth to your gums start to wither away, often resulting in lost or shifting teeth. This advanced stage can also lead to bone loss. Both of these side effects are usually irreversible; they can affect your bite, oral health and overall systemic health. We don't tell you these things to scare you; we're telling you so that you can be informed. By knowing about periodontal disease, you can recognize the early signs and get the proper treatment before your smile suffers. No matter the degree of your periodontal disease, our dentists and team can give you the care you need to restore your oral health.



Periodontal Disease Facts

- More than half of people over the age of 30 have some form of periodontal disease, but many of them do not know it.
- Periodontal disease has been known to affect your overall systemic health. Patients with periodontal disease have an increased risk of heart disease, stroke, diabetes, premature births and more.
- Periodontal disease is the #1 cause of tooth loss in adults.
- Periodontal disease manifests itself in a variety of symptoms, including bleeding and sore gums, lingering bad breath and increased tooth sensitivity.

How Do I Treat Periodontal Disease?

Treating periodontal disease depends largely on how severe your condition is. Treatment options range anywhere from in-depth dental cleanings to antibiotic treatments to surgery. Whatever your situation, we will work with you to determine which type of treatment is best.

Periodontal disease is caused by a buildup of plaque along the gum line. Such buildup can only be removed by a dentist or dental hygienist. With that said, the first step to treating periodontal disease is visiting the dentist. If you are in the early stages of periodontal disease, a basic, professional dental cleaning may be all you need. Depending on the amount of plaque buildup, our dentists may recommend a more in-depth cleaning called scaling and root planing. This procedure removes plaque from around the teeth, both above and beneath the gum line.

For patients who have developed deep periodontal pockets, there are more involved treatments available to

stop periodontal disease in its tracks and start the healing process. Some of these treatments include a pocket reduction surgery, gum grafts and gum shaping.

After our dentists examine your mouth and diagnoses the severity of your gum disease, we can put together a personalized treatment plan that will address your oral health needs and help you regain your beautiful smile once again.

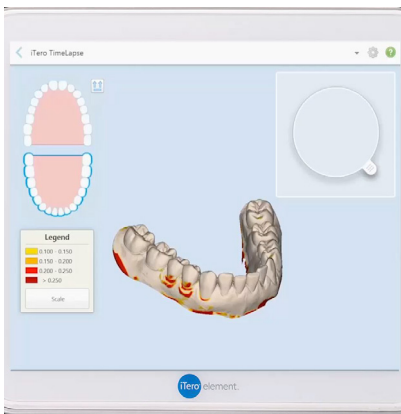

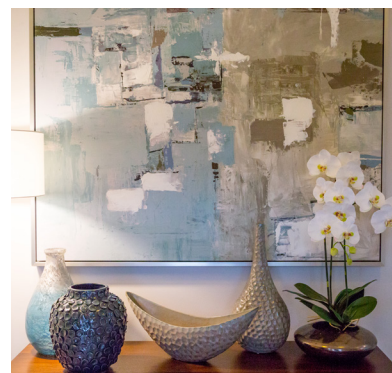

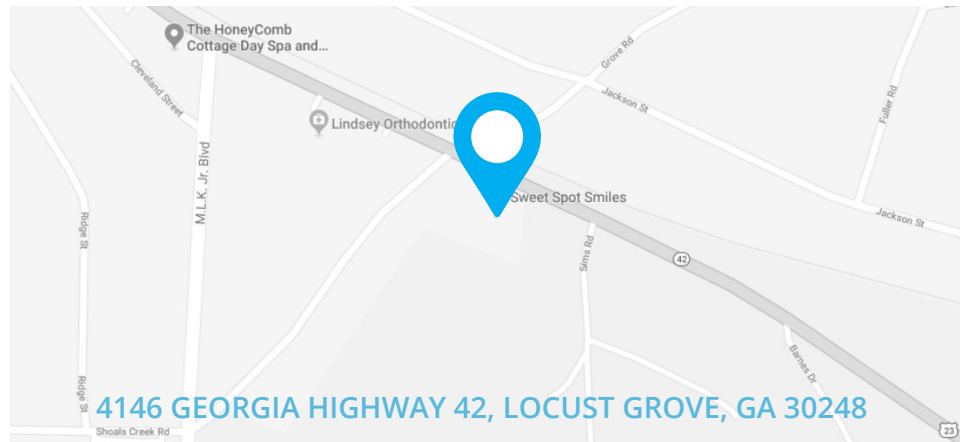
